### Dear K-5 Families,

This goal continues as we enter into the summer months. We want the kids to read. And read some more. It should be text of their choosing and their ability as they develop a love of reading. One strategy to figure out readability is the 5 finger test (see below).

Attached you will find a list of *suggestions* and *ideas*. However, scope out your bookcases, check out your local library, and just keep reading!

You will also find a reading log to fill out. The children should fill in what they've been enjoying each week and an opinion or comment about the book. Make sure to fill this out - there's a prize when you return to school in September.

### Five Finger Test for Readability:

To check the reading level of your book, take this simple test:

- 1. Open the book to the middle and choose any page to read.
- 2. Read the page.
- 3. Put out 1 finger for every word you do not know or cannot pronounce.
- 4. If you have 5 fingers out, the book is too difficult to read without help.
- 5. If you do not get any fingers up, but are reading very slowly and sounding out almost every word, you might not enjoy the book since all your reading energy is going into decoding.

#### Here's the finger guide:

- 1 Finger: This book is o.k. for you.
- 2 Fingers: Still good.
- 3 Fingers: Could be a bit hard for you to understand.
- 4 Fingers: Will be too difficult to read and understand.
- 5 Fingers: Choose another book.
